Life Force International's **Taheebo** is made with a pure extract obtained solely from the inner bark of the lapacho tree. The key active component extracted is lapachol, which has demonstrated antibiotic, anti-fungal, anti-inflammatory, antibacterial, and immunostimulant properties.^{1,2,3,4} Clinical studies of lapachol have shown that it possesses potential health supporting benefits as well as anti-parasitic properties.^{5,6}

Today, more than ever, the need for immune function support is vital to good health and a long life. Due to the many biological assaults on the human body, its entire defense system is constantly being bombarded with challenges of one type or another. Servings:

Taheebo comes in a 2-oz, amber-colored, glass bottle, which yields 60 servings @ 1 dropper-full per serving.* When taking 2 servings daily, Taheebo is a 30-day supply.
